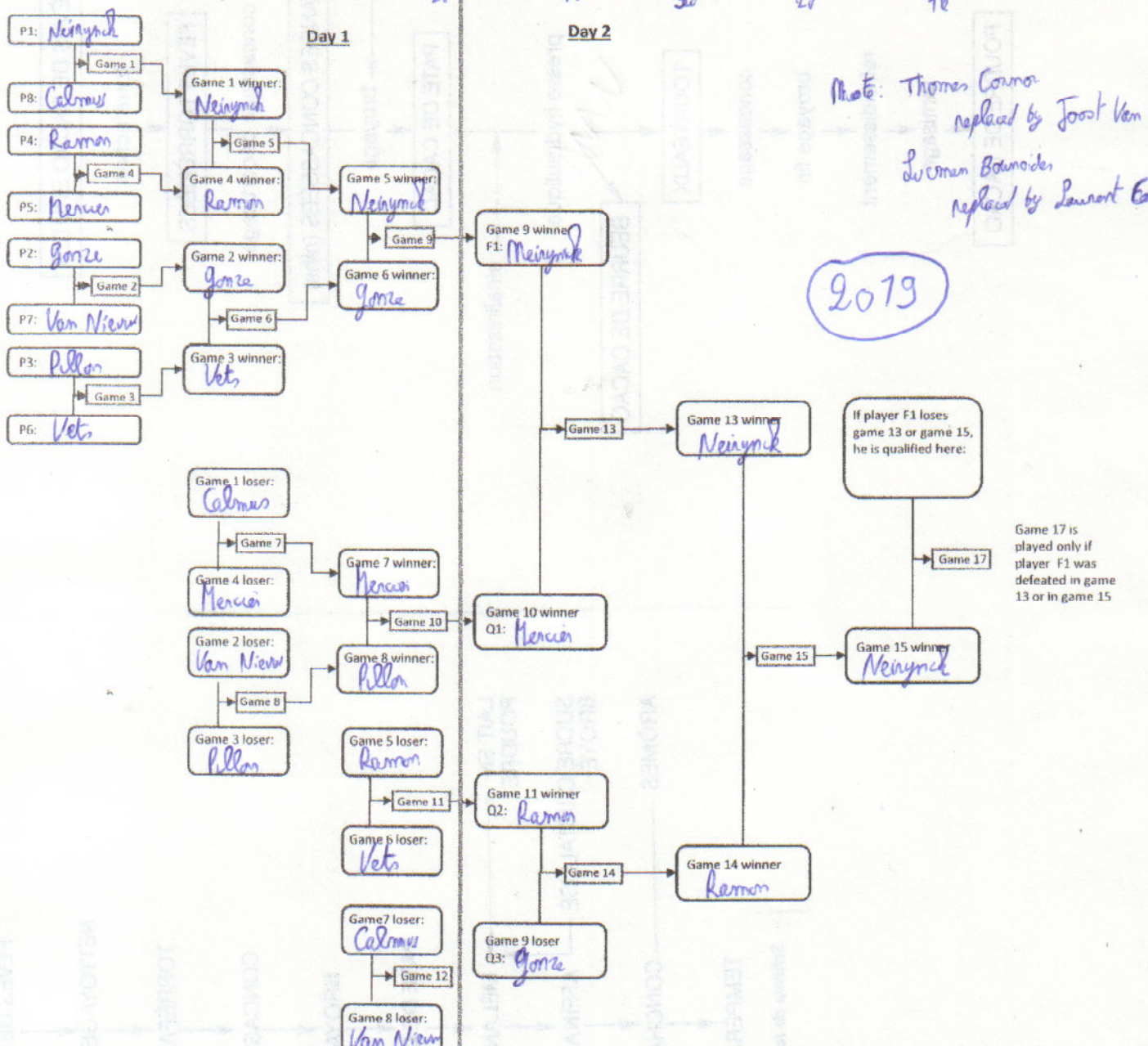


Belgium Go Championship final Tree (proposition)

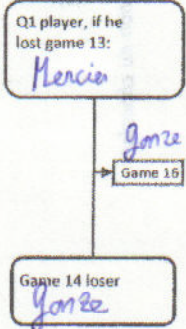
